Claremont, NH            Armande M. Rouleau, 93 formerly of Central Street in Claremont, NH died Saturday (January 22) at Elm Wood Center in Claremont, NH following a period of failing health. She was born in Black Lake, Quebec, Canada on June 10, 1917 the daughter of Philiias and Arzilda (Roy) Rouleau and had been a Claremont resident since 1948.
